Fees:

- Monthly tuition is based on the total number of classes September thru May and is broken down into 9 monthly payments. Payments are due by the 10th of each month.
- September will be half price due to starting later in the month.

-Registration fee of \$65 to be turned in with registration form and will be applied to costume fees.

-Costume Fee is \$65 per class – all costumes must be paid by November 6th.

-Recital Fee is \$10 per child due by April 2nd.

-Must have a minimum of 5 students to have a class.
